Officer spoke with a victim in reference to a harassing letter victim received from his ex-spouse, a report was placed on file.

Officer was dispatched to the 1000 block of South Locust Street in reference to a possible sexual assault which had occurred, case is under investigation.

**March 08, 2015**

Carlinville Police Department was dispatched to the 400 block of Sumner St. in reference to a vehicle that was on fire, upon arriving at the scene, Officers discovered a burning vehicle, that was fully engulfed, Officers then secured the scene, case is under investigation.

Officer was dispatched to the 500 block of West 1st Street apartments for a burglary that occurred, upon arrival I met with victim who stated that victims apartment was broke into this morning and pointed to a window that was open, victim stated they were missing \$500 dollars in twenty dollar bills, case is under investigation.

Officers spoke with a parent in reference to a possible child abuse case, case is under investigation.

Officer was parked west of the Hickory Street apartments, facing east on Hickory St., when Officer observed a white SUV driving recklessly, it then turned west onto Hickory St. off of Mayo St. The vehicle made a right turn at a high rate of speed and did not use it's turn signal. Officer also observed that the vehicle had one inoperable headlight. Due to the fact that vehicle was driving erratically and at a high rate of speed in a residential neighborhood, Officer activated his emergency lights to attempt to make a traffic stop on the vehicle. As the vehicle approached squad car, it gained speed dramatically. Officer notified dispatch that he was attempting to make a traffic stop, after losing sight of vehicle it was found abounded in the area of MCDD, Officers also observed that the front end of the suspect's vehicle had extensive damage, vehicle was impounded and case is under investigation.
