January 9, 2015

Officers were dispatched to the Bank and Trust Company in the 900 block of West Main to retrieve a counterfeit bill that they had received, the bill was sent to the Secret Service for investigation.

Officers were advised by dispatch of damage to a vehicle window located in the 200 block of Pine Street. Unknown subject had broken the passenger side front window of victim's truck.

Officers were called to a residence on Reid Street for possible underage drinking, a juvenile was cited for illegal consumption by a minor.

Cited Kila L. Harris, 26, Carlinville for operating uninsured motor vehicle at West Main and Oak Street.

January 15, 2015

Officers spoke to plaintiff at the 500 block of North Broad Street that stated an unknown person hit the night drop box for the library.

Officers responded to the 700 block of Anderson and advised victims car had been broken into last night, this morning victim noticed several items missing from inside of vehicle.

Officers responded to possible damage to a building on the north side of Dunn's Ambulance Service garage. Officers located the damage on the north exterior wall of 939 North Broad St. Officer Officers located several pieces of broken plastic and glass, which appeared to have come from a broken headlight or turn signal on the ground below the damage on the wall. There also appeared to be black paint that had transferred from the suspected vehicle onto the damaged wall. After investigating the damage, Officers made contact with, the building owner who advised that the damage was not there yesterday and could only have happened on the night of the 14th or early morning of the 15th. Arrested Jesse R. McCarver, 33, Carlinville for aggravated battery, leaving the scene of a property damage accident, failure to report an accident, failure to reduce speed to avoid an accident and operating uninsured motor vehicle.

Officer spoke with victim in reference to a lawn ornament stolen from victim's front yard in the 300 block of South Oak Street.
